<u>Annual Fundraising Walk</u> On Friday 25th June the whole school community is meeting for our annual walk around Glenariff Forest Park. We will meet at the Forest Park carpark at 9.30am. All children should be collected at 1pm. If your child or children need a lift with staff please indicate below; if travelling with staff the children must be at the school ready to leave at 9.15am sharp.

Normally we use this event to raise money for school funds, however this year we have decided to encourage the children to bring in donations for our **Grannies' Pennies** charity, which we have been focusing on over the past few weeks. Each £15.90 raised will feed a child in Africa for the whole year.

The distances walked in the forest will vary according to your child's age and will range from approximately 1.5 miles to 4 miles. At the end of the walk, the ladies from Glenariff Improvement Group have again very kindly agreed to provide food and treats for the children. We are very appreciative of this very generous gesture, it really is a highlight for the children to be able to walk, eat and have fun together to celebrate the end of the school year in our beautiful Forest Park, this year especially.

The children should bring with them a bottle of water in a plastic bottle and a healthy snack. (No crisps or fizzy drinks please). They should also take a light jacket or coat and a scooped sunhat. They must wear their school polo t-shirt and school jumper and they may wear shorts or leggings. They must also wear a comfortable pair of walking shoes or trainers.
